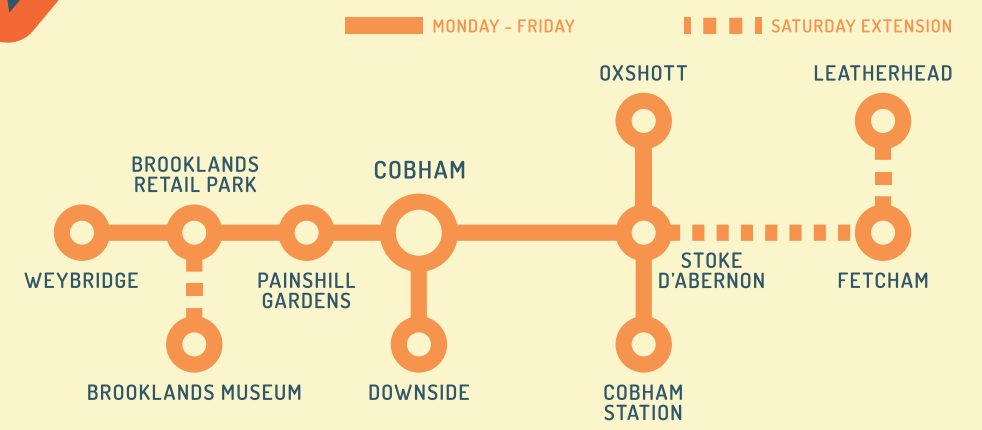

Friends of Chatterbus needs Champions like you!

When you jump into your car today to go to work, or to visit the shops, give some thought to the fact that for some of your neighbours, making such a simple journey is very difficult indeed. For those without access to a car, poor public transport in our area causes severe hardship. For this reason, the Chatterbus service was launched in April 2015 by members of the local community.

How is this essential service funded? Fare revenue from our many loyal passengers (well over 30,000 journeys in the first two years of operation) and support from our local government and business sponsors together cover about two thirds of our operating costs. This leaves a substantial gap, which must be filled by donations from local businesses and residents in order to keep the bus on the road. Now, Friends of Chatterbus has been set up so that local people can show their support through donations.

Make a regular donation by standing order

A steady income that we can rely on enables us to plan for the future and reduces administration costs. Standing orders are easy and efficient for both us and. Any amount donated monthly, quarterly or annually will be gratefully received and all the money goes directly to help keep the Chatterbus wheels rolling. Here are some suggested donation levels:
